Zachariah, Carey and Jericho
Missionaries to Paraguay



Zachariah and Carey Ritland begin serving with AFLC World Missions as Lay Missionaries to Paraguay March 2025. They have answered the call to serve alongside Matthew and Ednay Abel to plant churches in Paraguay.

Worship (Carey): I was again overwhelmed by God's goodness as I pictured and remembered all the different places, we have been able to worship God with others. How services looked different in different cultures. I love knowing people from all different parts of the world will be gathering and worshipping. Some may not be able to go to a church, like we do, but I know Christ is alive in their hearts and homes.

Zach: My mom and sisters have been visiting us and are back in the USA now. What a great time together! Jericho enjoyed having a houseful of moms attending to his every need. For the time they were here I don't think I changed a single diaper. We showed them around and introduced them to people in our lives. It was really good to have them see our world! Ten-year-old Adeline asked lots of good questions. One of her questions, in summary, was if it is better to not believe in God at all or be Catholic. I told her I don't know which is better, but I know that the only thing that counts, in the end, is if you are trusting in Christ alone. Not Jesus plus good deeds or Jesus plus religious observances. Being Catholic doesn't save you nor does membership in an evangelical church save you. Being an atheist doesn't save you nor does believing in a god save you. Only Jesus Christ saves, and when we put our trust in Him and Him alone, we can have full assurance of our salvation.
