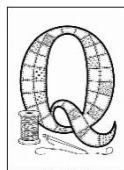

Hope: The first candle lit, often called the Prophecy Candle, represents hope and the anticipation of Christ's coming.

Peace: The second candle, known as the Bethlehem Candle, symbolizes peace.

Joy: The third candle, the Shepherd's Candle, represents joy, and is often pink to signify "Gaudete Sunday" (Sunday of rejoice).

Love: The fourth candle, the Angel's Candle, represents love.
