The World Mission Board has granted their request to continue service with World Missions through July to allow them this time to travel back to Uganda. They will continue to need personal support funds from AFLC World Missions through the end of July. Please pray for them during this time of transition and pray for the work in Uganda. Pastor Nate has been called to work with International Orality Institute. He will begin his new position on August 1, 2024.
