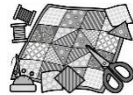

## Missionary Spotlight



### **Pastor Brent & Emily Raan**

Pastor Brent and Emily Raan accepted the call as AFLC missionaries in 2016 and are now serving in Uganda, Africa with their 4 children: Amaleah, Sarala, Isaiah, and Amari. They have been living in Jinja, Uganda for the past two and a half years. The main focus of their ministry has been to partner with the national leaders in the advancement of Ambassador Institute, an orality ministry of AFLC World Missions. The program is solidly founded on the importance of Scripture, using oral teaching to share doctrinal truths. Brent and Emily are preparing to plant a new church in a region of Uganda that has had little opportunity to hear the gospel. Although war torn by the atrocities of Joseph Kony, the town of Gulu, in northern Uganda, has seen a population growth with people starting to return in the last five years. The Raan family anticipates the opportunity to share the hope of Jesus Christ with hurting people.
